PREMIUM CHECKS!

Premium checks will be mailed unless presented at the Fair. Premium checks MUST BE cashed within 90 days. Awards are paid from entries made by the judge's clerk on the official judging sheets, and NOT from award stickers placed on entry.

HOW DO YOU ENTER?

1. Review the Table of Contents to find the area of your interest. Then check the deadlines and dates.
2. Read each department's rules and regulations. Double-check deadlines, receiving dates and other information.
3. Find entry form (white pages in back of book) completely. Mail into Fairgrounds or bring to Administrative Office before deadline with fees (if applicable). Use separate forms for exhibitor and each department.
4. Senior class, 18 years and older. Junior class, 17 years and younger.
5. Make checks payable to Santa Cruz County Fair. Checks returned from bank will be an additional \$25.00 charge.
6. We encourage you to share your Entry Guide with friends and family. Photocopies of entry forms are accepted and encouraged. Additional copies of entry forms and guidebooks are available in the Administrative Office, local libraries and online at www.santacruzcountyfair.com
7. All local and state rules apply. State rules and scorecards are available in the Administrative Office.
8. All classes and sections will be judged by the American system and/or the Danish system.
 - ❖ **American:** The judging process to rank exhibits against one another and award one first placing, one second, etc.
 - ❖ **Danish:** The judging process to compare each exhibit on its own merit against the scorecard or recognized standard and award as many first placings, etc. as merited.
9. All entry forms must be received or postmarked, not postage meter, by Saturday, August 7, 2010, except where noted.
10. For your convenience the Fair Office will be open, 8AM – 5PM on deadline day, which is Saturday, August 7, 2010.
11. Awards are paid from entries made by the judge's clerk on the "Official Judging Sheets" and not from award stickers placed on entry. Judges decisions are final.
12. All entries must be delivered and picked up on days specified.
