<b>ENTRY DEADLINE</b>	AUGUST 7, 2010
<b>ENTRY FEE</b>	\$2.00 per rabbit per class; \$3.00 per exhibitor for showmanship plus \$5.00 exhibitor entry pass.
<b>RECEIVING DATE</b>	Friday, September 17, 2010, 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. Enter at Horse Show Gate – <b>must have entry pass</b>
<b>JUDGING</b>	Friday, September 17, 2010, 9:30 AM
<b>SHOWMANSHIP</b>	Friday, September 17, 2010, 9:30 AM

<b>RELEASE DATE</b>	Immediately after judging. ALL RABBITS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS IMMEDIATELY AFTER SHOW ENDS.
<b>SYSTEM OF JUDGING</b>	American

Awards are paid from entries made by the judge's clerks on the "Official Judging Sheets" and not from award stickers placed on entry. Judges decisions are final.

This is a youth only show. Youth must be able to handle their own rabbits and be available to put them on the table.

Rabbit show limited to Santa Cruz, Monterey, San Benito and Santa Clara Counties. The committee requests assistance for the show of at least one adult from each participating 4-H club or FFA chapter.

Please check in with the clerk at the registration table.

### DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

- The entry limit for the Rabbit Show will be two entries per exhibitor per class per division. The show limit will be 250 rabbits. Entries after the first 250 animals will be returned with entry fee monies. ALL RABBIT ENTRIES ARE TO BE MADE ON THE ENTRY FORMS FOUND IN THIS BOOK. ENTRY FORM MAY BE DUPLICATED.
- Official ARBA sanctioned show.
- Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all District Fair rabbit shows provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. Legs will be awarded according to American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. rules.
- All animals must be identified by legible, permanent ear marking in left ear which MUST correspond to those on the entry form. Pet rabbits are excluded from required ear markings.
- Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same Breed and Class will not be allowed. Entries with

duplicate ear numbers will have one of those rabbits eliminated. The entry fee will not be returned.

- Animals will be shown and judged in Showroom divisions recognized by the ARBA. Divisions will be established by the number of rabbits entered in any given breed and any given variety within that breed. ANY DIVISION LISTED THAT RECEIVES LESS THAN FIVE ENTRIES MAY BE DROPPED, AND THE RABBITS ENTERED WILL BE PLACED WITH OTHERS OF THAT BREED OR IN THE APPROPRIATE "ALL OTHER" DIVISION.
- The judge will eliminate those animals which have disqualifications from competition. They will count when computing the number of rabbits shown in the class.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to take the rabbit to the show table when the class is called for it to be judged. Those rabbits absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of rabbits in the class.
- Rabbits entered in a class, which are the wrong sex, breed, or variety is to be eliminated from the class and the number in the class corrected accordingly.
- All Best of Breeds must stay for Best in Show. If youth leave prior to Best in Show all rabbit premiums may be forfeited.
- The exhibitor is to check the show cards at the beginning of the Rabbit Show and report any discrepancies to the Show Secretary immediately. **NO CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED DURING THE SHOW.** Substitutions can only be made within the same division, sex, variety and class and must be submitted in writing ten (10) days prior to the show date.
- Pedigree papers or a Bill of Sale showing the required ownership period (30 days) may be used instead of a pedigree if ear number and other required entry information are shown on the Bill of Sale. This should be available upon request the day of the show.
- The age in months (3 months) must be entered on the entry form for each animal entered; however, rabbits are to be entered by weight and age (see showroom classes).
- MEAT PEN:** 1st and 2nd Place meat pens by youth to be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction Saturday, September 18, 2010. If top entries do not meet minimum quality standards, the Rabbit Auction will be canceled. RABBIT MEAT PEN AUCTION DOES NOT COUNT AS A JUNIOR LIVESTOCK MARKET ANIMAL AND CAN BE SOLD IN ADDITION TO OTHER LIVESTOCK. **Exhibitors' mandatory Jr. Livestock Auction picture fee will be deducted from auction check.** Only animals bred and raised by exhibitor are eligible for entry. 4 H Leader's or FFA Advisor's verification needed on entry form.
- Exhibitors must attend the Santa Cruz County Fair Rabbit Show with their rabbits. Consideration will be given to those showing other species on a case-by-case basis, with prior notice in writing.
- Thank you letters for awards are due at the end of the show.

6. ENTRY FEE: \$3.00. PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.

**DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Limit 2 entries per exhibitor.
2. An exhibitor may only sell one (1) pen of rabbits.
3. Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion will be sold at the Jr. Livestock Auction. If same exhibitor owns both Grand and Reserve Grand Champion meat pens, only the Grand Champion Meat pen will be sold.
4. **Animals must return for Junior Livestock Auction on Saturday, September 18, 2010.**
5. ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 each pen of three.
6. **Meat Pens must be entered on Market Entry Form.**
7. Exhibitors who are not entering large market or breeding animals do not pay wristband fee.
